


# Serving Mass at Emmanuel Catholic Church – A Training Resource for Emmanuel Altar Boys




### **ENTRANCE PROCESSION**


The Entrance Procession sets the tone for the entire Mass. The pace of the procession should be stately and dignified, we are not in a rush. Mass moves us from the realm of the temporal to the realm of the eternal. We are not in a hurry to return to hustle and bustle of life! This is God's time!

The pace of the procession should be stately and dignified. We are not in a rush!







1. Ac1, Ac2 genuflect as a group at the steps and immediately go to position.

- 2. Pg1, Pg2 genuflect at the steps and immediately go to position, likewise with Le.
- 3. MC2 enter sanctuary after Le, do NOT genuflect








- - 1. MC1 enters sanctuary goes just to right. Don't genuflect.
  - 2. Pr enters sanctuary and genuflects.
  - 3. MC1 and MC2 genuflect with Pr then go to respective positions.


# FROM THE INCENSATION OF THE ALTAR THROUGH THE COLLECT

The Priest incenses the altar in preparation for the Holy Sacrifice. Incense is a sign of reverence and a dedication of the altar. The altar is where the One Sacrifice of Calvary is represented to the faithful during Mass.


In the Collect, the Priest as shepherd of the flock entrusted to him by God, gathers (collects) and offers the prayers of the people to God on their behalf.




- 1. After Pr reverences Altar, Th IMMEDIATELY brings thurible and incense boat to Pr.
- 2. Deacon assists Pr in preparing incense.
- 3. After incense prepared, Th hands thurible to Pr and IMMEDIATELY goes back down stairs to wait.



1. Pr incenses altar and crucifix.




- 1. After Pr is done incensing the altar, Th IMMEDIATELY gets the thurible from Pr and puts it back on incense stand.
- 2. Pr and De go to sedilia.




- 1. Remain standing for Penitential Rite.
- 2. Gloria is then said/sung (except during Advent/Lent).
- 3. Pr prays Collect then ALL sit.

# 1st AND 2nd READINGS AND GOSPEL


In the readings and especially the Gospel, we hear the Word of God, that is, Our Lord Jesus Christ speaking to us through the human authors of Holy Scripture who without error wrote under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit.




- Notes:
  - 1. As soon as 2nd reading begins, MC, TBs, and Th go to sacristy. Do NOT pass in front of Pr.
  - 2. Th brings thurible and boat to sacristy.
  - 3. MC helps TBs and Th as needed.



- 1. As soon as Gospel Acclamation starts and all stand, Th goes directly to Pr while MC and TBs get into position.
- 2. As soon as incense is prepared, Th goes behind altar and waits with MC and TBs.




1. De receives blessing from Pr and gets Gospel from altar.



- 1. As soon as De starts down the steps with Gospel, THEN TBs, Th and MC get in position at ambo.
- 2. After Gospel proclaimed, MC, TBs, and Th go back to sacristy.
- 3. All Altar Boys remain standing until De gets back to chair. Sit in unison with De NOT with congregation.
- 4. Th lights and puts another charcoal briquette in thurible and then takes thurible/boat back to thurible stand.
- 5. All go back to seats.

# HOMILY, PROFESSION OF FAITH, AND UNIVERSAL PRAYER


The Priest or Deacon gives the homily emphasizing the themes from the readings. After the homily we all profess our common faith by reciting the Creed ("I believe...") and then we present our petitions (Universal Prayer) to our merciful Father in heaven.




- 1. Just before end of Creed, BB gets notebook with petitions and stands in front of Pr.
- 2. BB returns to position after Universal Prayer is over.

## RECEPTION AND PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS


The sacred elements for the sacrifice (i.e., the bread and wine) and the offerings are brought to the sanctuary by representatives of the people. This signifies the participation of the entire People of God in the Eucharistic Sacrifice. Furthermore, it signifies that with Jesus, we are offering our very lives to God in gratitude for all He has done for us.




- 1. Servers place Sacred Vessels and Missal on Altar while ushers are taking up collection.
- 2. De receives gifts from people with Ac's and BB.
- 3. Cruets are taken to Credence Table and Ciborium to altar.
- 4. BB takes offering basket to sacristy.



- 1. Pg1 closes gates while De prepares altar for Pr.
- 2. After Pr prepares bread and wine, Th IMMEDIATELY brings thurible and incense boat to Pr.
- 3. Deacon assists Pr in preparing incense.
- 4. After incense prepared, Th hands thurible to Pr and IMMEDIATELY goes back down to wait for De.




1. Pr incenses gifts, altar and crucifix.




- 1. De incenses Pr.
- 2. After Pr is incensed, AC and Pg bring lavabo bowl, water and towel to Pr for purification of his hands.
- 3. During this time De incenses any Cc and then the people.
- 4. De returns thurible to Th.
- 5. Th, MC1, TB1, TB2 go to Sacristy to prepare torches and incense for consecration

# HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS AND COMMUNION

The Holy Sacrifice is the most sacred part of the Mass. Our Lord's Sacrifice on Calvary is miraculously made present to us (re-presented). The Priest, acting in persona Christi (in the person of Christ), consecrates the sacred elements which become the body, blood, soul, and divinity of Our Lord (cf. transubstantiation). During this part of the Mass we adore Our Lord on our knees, we remember His great sacrifice, and we prepare to receive him into our own bodies (i.e., commune with Him) in a most intimate union of our humanity with His divinity.




- 1. At the BEGINNING of the Sanctus, MC2, TB1, Th, TB2 exit Sacristy and get in position with Th directly in front of Pr
- 2. Kneel with congregation at the end of Sanctus


- 1. At Epiclesis, bells are rung a single time.
- 2. At elevation of Host and again at the elevation of Precious Blood bells are rung 3 times during each elevation.
- 3. At each elevation Th incenses with 3 double-swings
- 4. AFTER the great Amen, MC2 TB1, TB2, Th stand and return to Sacristy



- 1. One altar boy (Gospel side) and two altar boys (Epistle side) take patens and accompany Pr, CC or EM1, and De in distributing Communion.
- 2. EM2 takes Communion to Choir.

## PURIFICATION OF THE SACRED VESSELS

The sacred vessels are purified to ensure no fragment or part of our Lord's body and blood remain in the sacred vessels. Every fragment of Our Lord's body, every drop of His blood is precious and we want to make sure neither is inadvertently lost or treated without due reverence.




- 1. While De is purifying vessels, server from Epistle side gets Missal from altar of sacrifice and puts it on altar of repose, server on Gospel side gets patens.
- 2. Server gets sacred vessels from De after they are purified.
- 3. After De goes to seat, all servers stand, go to seats, and sit in unison.

# PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION AND RECESSIONAL

Having received Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist, we have received our "food for the journey" which strengthens and enables us to live lives worthy of our calling. Rejoicing and praising God, we leave the sacred space to retake our place in the world and be a holy example and witness – evangelists for Our Lord to everyone we meet by what we say, what we do, and who we are! 



- 1. Pg1 opens gates.
- 2. Pr says "Let us pray" and all stand.
- 3. MC2 and TBs go to sacristy to light torches.
- 4. Pr prays Prayer after Communion and final hymn begins.


